

## Elworth Drafted Amicus Brief in Successful Appellate Decision

The Illinois Association of Defense Trial Counsel (IDC) filed an amicus brief supporting an appellee in a dispute concerning the conversion of a respondent in discovery to a defendant under Section 2-402 of the Code of Civil Procedure.
